



Dear Vaughan Public Library Customers,

The wellbeing of our staff and customers is our number one priority. Thus, we are temporarily closing all of our locations as a preventative measure to inhibit the spread of COVID-19. **As a result, all branches will be closed from Saturday, March 14th at 5 pm until the morning of Monday, April 6th at which point regular hours will resume.**

All programming during this time will also be cancelled. If you have paid for a program, this will be refunded in full.

This decision aligns with the closure of publicly-funded schools in Ontario and the closure of all city recreation facilities and community centres within the City of Vaughan.

We will also be waiving fines for all items due within the time period of this closure. We request that customers please do not return any items until April 6th or later.

We would also like to remind all customers that we do have a vast array of digital resources available for **FREE** from our website, including e-books, audiobooks, movies and comprehensive databases.
