Make an Origami Knight Helmet

You will need:

- 1 sheet of 8.5" x 11" paper
- Tape



What to do:

1) Fold your paper in half vertically, then open it back up.





2) Fold your paper horizontally (top to bottom). Make sure the open end is at the bottom.



3) Take the top right corner and fold it to the middle, using the centre line as a guide.




4) Repeat step 3 on the left side.



5) Take the top layer of the bottom edge and fold up.



6) Turn your paper over, then fold the bottom edge up as you did in step 5.



7) Unfold your paper back to its original size.



8) Using the top fold line as a guide, fold the top edge over.



9) Take the top right corner and fold it to the middle, using the centre fold as a guide.



10) Repeat step 9 with the left side.



11) Fold the top half down. Your paper should now look like the back of an envelope.



12) Carefully turn your paper over. Take the top right and left corners and fold them to the middle.







13) Take the bottom edge and fold up.



14) Fold this strip in half, top to bottom.



15) Bring the ends of this strip towards the middle. Where the ends meet in the middle, tuck one strip inside the other. Place a small piece of tape over the place where the two ends meet to secure it.





16) That's it! You now have your own knight's helmet.
