Phase 2 Expansion of Parking Lot — Vaughan City Hall and Civic Centre Resource Library



Please be advised that construction at the west parking lot of Vaughan City Hall and adjacent parking lot at the Civic Centre Resource Library, located at 2141 and 2191 Major Mackenzie Dr. respectively, will begin in late August 2021, with expected completion by late December 2021, weather permitting.

The <u>Civic Centre Resource Library</u> will remain open during construction. Vaughan City Hall remains closed to the public due to COVID-19. For the latest updates on COVID-19, visit <u>vaughan.ca/COVID19</u>.

The purpose of the construction is to further expand and enhance the parking lot at City Hall and the Civic Centre Resource Library. With the completion of Phase 2, the project will provide 588 parking spaces combined, and include various enhancements, such as:

- upgraded stormwater management infrastructure
- new pavement surfacing
- upgraded lighting and security system
- a new pedestrian walkway
- landscaping (tree planting)
- accommodation for future electric vehicle (EV) charging stations



The construction will be rolled out in stages to minimize disruption. Please note the following:

- There will be a nominal, temporary reduction of parking spaces throughout the course of construction.
- There may be temporary interruptions to access routes within the parking lot during construction, including the main driveway and the driveway adjacent to the Civic Centre Resource Library. The City asks that all visitors exercise caution and respect the construction signage, fencing and barriers where present.
- The number of designated visitor parking spaces will be maintained during construction.
