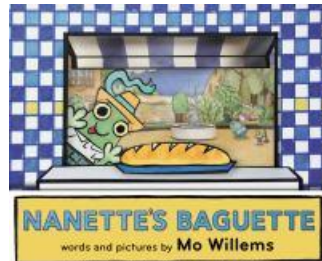

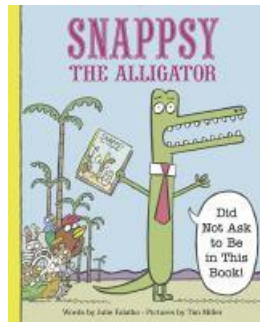


Nanette's Baguette

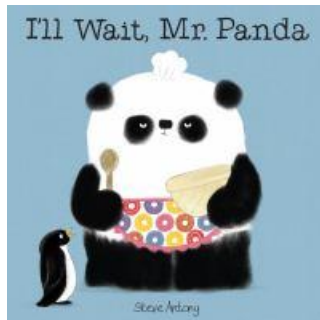


Snappy the Alligator (did Not Ask to Be in This Book!)

AngelaC says "A wonderful visual book that uses drawing, collage, instant photography and a typewriter to push the reader to be inspired by all that is around them."

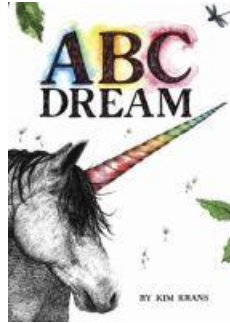


That's Not A Hippopotamus!

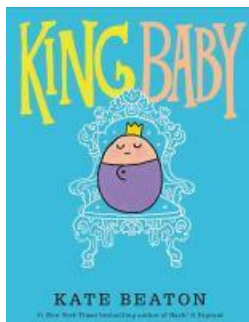


Good Night Owl

RachelK says "Bright, warm colours, eccentric and detailed illustrations, and a funny storyline make this book a fun bedtime- or anytime! Story."

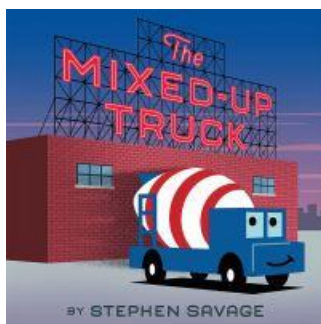


King Baby

Kasey says "Honestly one of the funniest books I read all year. I laughed out loud, more than once! Great, silly illustrations and perfect pacing."

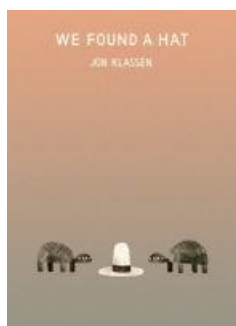


The Mixed-up Truck

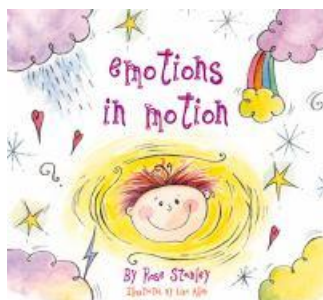


We Found A Hat

AndreaW says "One of our favourites, Jon Klassen, finishes this trilogy with the tale of two turtles and only one hat."

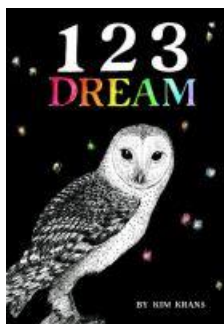


Emotions in Motion

DianeB says "it explains feelings in words that are well-described and illustrated for kids to understand – what each emotion looks like and feels like"

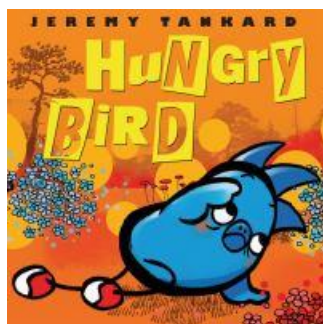


123 Dream
