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PROJECT FACTS AND FIGURES

- Planning began in 1985; project delayed due to budgetary constraints
- Planning resurrected in 1992 with changes to original design
- Official opening ceremonies held June 12, 1994
- Opened to the public June 13, 1994
- Renovated 2018/2019
- 36,500 square feet on one floor

DESIGN FEATURES

- Design consists of a compact, square block, covered colonnade, entry lobby and main library hall
- Lobby leads centrally from the colonnade to the library's main hall, a double-height space extending the full length of the block, providing large windows to the north and south as well as clerestory windows with study alcoves
- Accessibility features (AODA compliant); renovations to entrance, lobby, circulation and information desk areas, and staff workroom, due to Infrastructure Stimulus Funding from

the Province of Ontario.

ABOUT BATHURST CLARK RESOURCE LIBRARY

- First resource branch in the City of Vaughan, serving immediate residential and commercial areas with resources and programs for all users
- Contains centralized local studies collection; branch collection is 110,000 items not including electronic databases, eBook and eAudio collections, and streaming services
- 1 meeting room with capacity for 30 people theatre style seating or 14 people boardroom/classroom style
- 2 group study rooms
- Children's Learn It! space
- Teen area with bench/table seating
- Self-checkin/checkout for library materials
