Vaughan Public Library Board Awarded Joyce Cunningham Award for Board of the Year

VAUGHAN, ONTARIO – The Vaughan Public Library (VPL) Board and other Ontario Library Boards have received the Joyce Cunningham Award for Library Board of the Year. This award is given to a Public Library Board that participated in a collaborative effort that has demonstrated a high level of collaboration and innovation to produce outstanding results. The high-performance Public Library Board awarded this prestigious award is a team of goaloriented, highly-skilled individuals who value diversity and demonstrate their commitment to the team and support team success.

VPL's Library Board's devotion to building a world-class library system for everyone, cultivating relationships and formal partnerships, and championing a healthy and dynamic workplace for all staff is a small fraction of why they received this award.

Key Accomplishments:

- VPL was the first library in Ontario to introduce curbside pickup on May 20, 2020. Almost 700,000 items were borrowed through this service, while VPL's Resource Libraries were open
- VPL was required to pivot to a digital model for programming, and under their direction, an average of 5,000 customers attended virtual programs every month
- In the Summer of 2020, the VPL Board removed a significant barrier to library access by adopting a Fine Free policy allowing 3,000 customers to borrow from the collection once again
- The Reflection of Racism & Discrimination series was led by Vice Chair of the Board and attended by over 700 customers
- The VPL Board has overseen significant growth, which will see the number of branches grow from 10 to 13 during their term. As a result of an ingenious partnership with Mackenzie Health, Mackenzie Health Vaughan Library opened in September 2021 and is supplying medical research support
