WHAT:

Vaughan Fan Con is a day-long convention with workshops, cosplay, gaming, special guests and more at the Civic Centre Resource Library on Saturday, September 29, 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. Over 800 people attended the first Vaughan Fan Con held at Civic Centre Resource Library last year.

The event features:

- Cosplay, for kids too, including a photoschoots;
- Demonstrations of virtual reality, including Oculus Rift and Sphero, along with *maker* services like the button maker and vinyl cutter:
- Workshops and presentations with guest speakers from the science fiction community on a variety of topics;
- Gaming including video games, table top games and the Pokémon League;
- Kids programs such as storytimes and a Pokémon Scavenger Hunt:
- Various STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics) activities;
- An opportunity to speak with representatives from local fan clubs and artists.
