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SUMMARY

Under the direction of a designated supervisor, provide staff assistance before and after programs. Assist in a variety of programs, everything from computer basics to coding and STEAM – and guide young participants through a coding project. **In-person only.**

- 2. Help guide participants in completing a coding project.
- 3. Create an encouraging and positive environment during the programs.
- 4. Good attendance and punctuality is required.
- 5. Supports the Mission, Vision and Values of Vaughan Public Libraries.
- 6. Responsible following Health & Safety policies and procedures.
- 7. Record hours worked and tasks accomplished if required for community service placements.
- 8. Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Completed Grade 8 and a minimum of 14 years of age.
- Proficient in relevant computer technologies and programs.
- Possesses coding knowledge (i.e. Scratch or more).
- · Ability to communicate courteously and effectively.
- Enthusiasm for working with kids.
- Patient, dependable, and reliable.
- All volunteers must show proof of COVID vaccine.

TIME COMMITMENT

1.5 hours per week for the entire duration of the 6-week program.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Volunteers must complete and submit a Tech Coaches application.
- Volunteers must submit two reference letters.
- Volunteers must successfully complete an interview if required by library staff.

TRAINING

Volunteers must attend an orientation/training session prior to participating in the program.
