Must be 14 years or older. • Holds expertise in Pokémon universe for players' benefit. • Shows enthusiasm and proficiency in Pokémon jargon. • Ability to learn and understand Pokémon game rules (TCG, Video Game etc.). • Enthusiasm for teaching children game and trading mechanics. • Ability to communicate courteously and effectively. • Enthusiasm for working with children, teens and adults. • Patient, dependable and reliable. • Volunteers 18 years or older must obtain and submit a Police Vulnerable Sector Check prior to participating in program. 	
TIME COMMITMENT <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Volunteers must commit to a minimum participation level of 3 hours (one session) per month as scheduled for six (6) months.
