Word and Naming Activities with your Baby

At night, talk to your baby about what both of you have done throughout the day (i.e. "We had breakfast, then played peek-a-boo...")

Call someone and put the phone on speaker.
Tell them to speak to your baby, and to listen if your baby responds.

Each time you do something, and your baby is watching you, tell your baby what you are doing (i.e. "I am cooking dinner.")

Bring your baby to different rooms in your home. In each room, tell your baby about the things in there with descriptive details (i.e. "This is a big, brown kitchen table.")

When talking to your baby, ask them questions like, "Where are the toys?" Pause and look at them to see if they'll respond or babble back.



Say a word or a sound that you think your baby has not heard before.
Repeat it a few times.
See if your baby attempts to say the word or imitate the sound.

When your baby babbles or makes a sound, imitate them, including their gestures.

Go around your home and find items with words on them (i.e. cereal boxes, book covers). Tell your baby what the words say and what the items are.

Go around your home looking for items that start with each letter of the alphabet. Tell your baby the letter and name of that item.

Repeat one to two syllable words to your baby, such as "mama" or "dada". Put your face close to them as you're saying the words, so they can see your mouth forming the shapes.

Singing Tip!

(Learn to one side with baby)
