Type of building:	
Basic building material: (stone, brick, wood, glass, logs, etc) What colour is the outside?	
Is your building well maintained or is it dilapidated and falling apart:	
Location of your building: (City? Town? Countryside? Wilderness?)	
How old is your building?	
Is your building in the real world or a fantasy world?	
How many stories does your building have? Does it have an attic or a basement?	
How many rooms does it have?

What is the roof like? What is it made out of? Is it steep? Flat?	
Does your building have towers or turrets? How many?	
What kind of windows does it have? Lots of windows? Big windows? Tall windows? Narrow windows?	
Is there a sidewalk going up to it? Is there a driveway?	
Other details: does it have a garden, trees, tennis courts, swimming pool? What are the grounds like?	
What's the front door like? Large? Small? A double door? What colour is it?	
Does it have any special exterior decorative features? (columns, porches, chimneys, gargoyles, carved stone or woodwork)
