Accessing LinkedIn Learning on a Mobile Device or Tablet

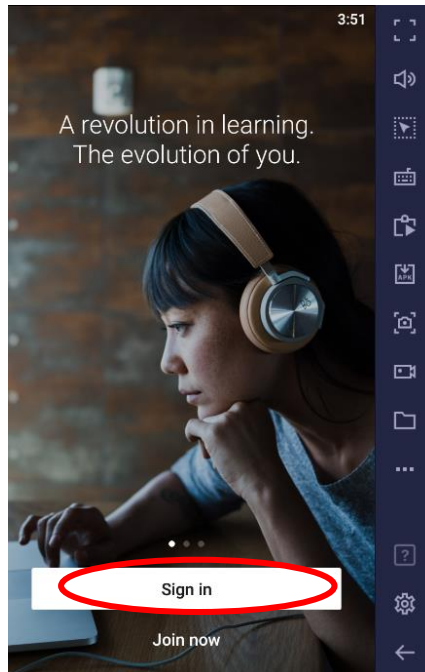
1. To access LinkedIn Learning on a mobile device or a tablet (Android or iOS) you will need to download the app from your respective App Store. On an Android device it will be the Google Play Store, on an Apple device it will be the iOS App Store.




2. Once you have logged onto your respective app store, search for the *LinkedIn Learning* app. The icon will look like this:



3. Click on the app to install it. It will be free to install. Once installed, open the app and select the “Sign In” option



4. Underneath the sign-in prompt for “email” there will be an option “Sign in with your library card”
5. The Library ID is: vaughanpl
6. Enter your library credentials and then select “Log in”. If you cannot remember your Library card PIN, please see the sections above to review how to reset your PIN.

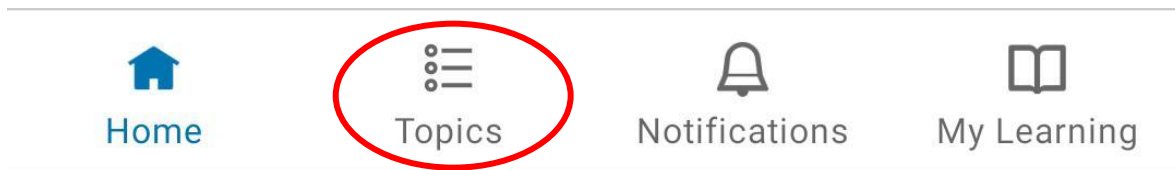

How to Browse Content on a Mobile Device or Tablet

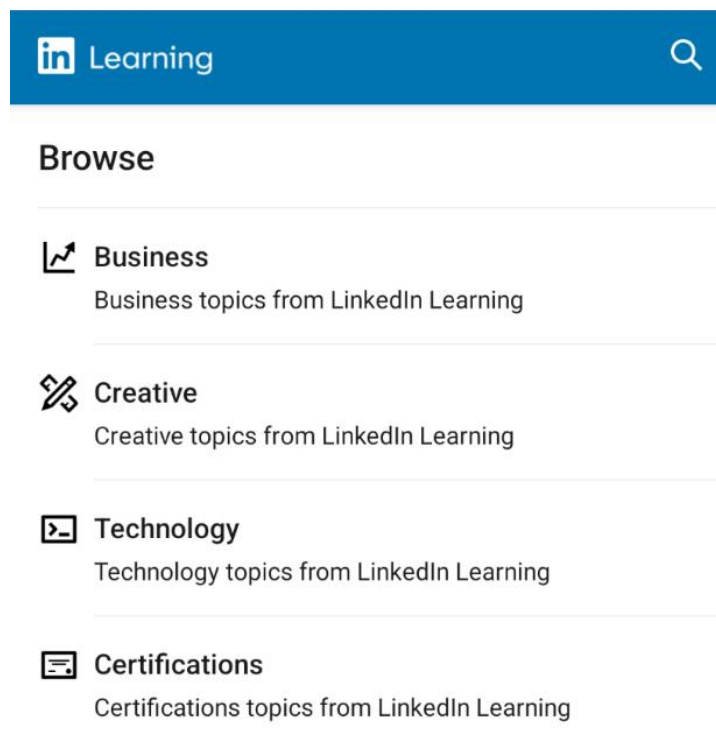
1. Once you've logged into the *LinkedIn Learning* app, you will be welcomed with a start screen. You can search for videos by clicking on the search button to bring up the search bar, and entering keywords, such as: Microsoft Excel, Powerpoint, or Websites.



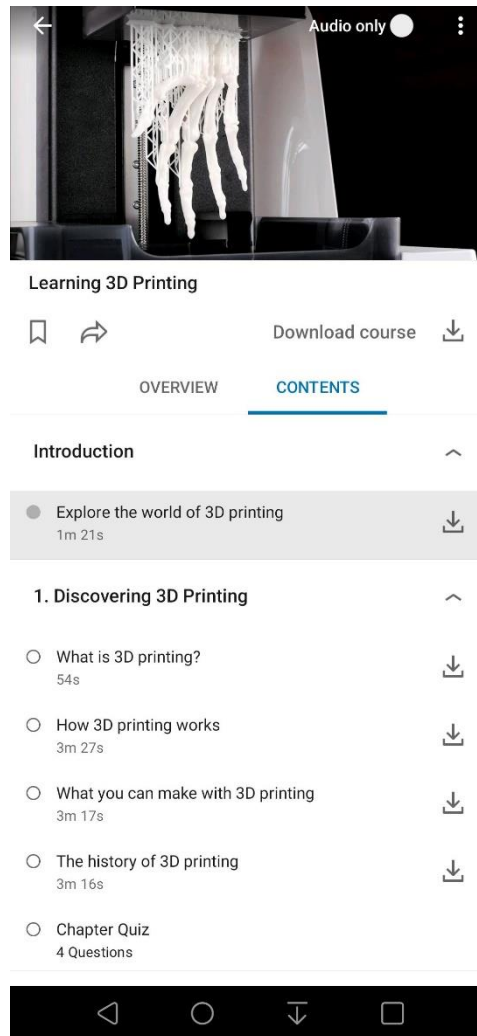
2. You can also click on the Topics Tab at the bottom of the app to open the access panel.



3. The topics panel has courses sorted by various subjects.

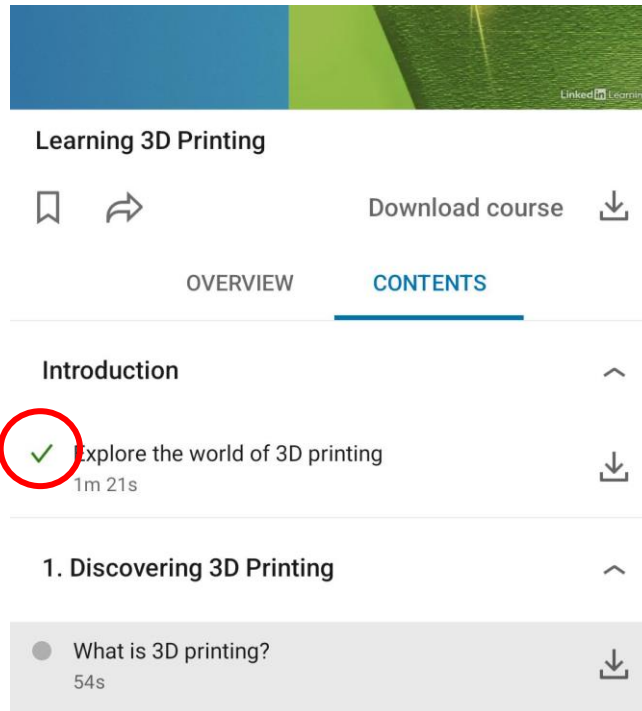


- Once you have located a course or video that interests you, tap on the image or title of the course. This will take you to the course's page, which will give you more information about what the course contains as well as all the videos, exercises, and assignments related to that course.

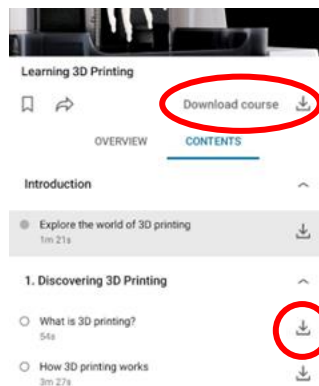


How to Take a Course on a Mobile Device or Tablet

1. To begin a course on the Learning app, simply go to the course page and begin watching the videos located in the contents section within that page. As you watch videos, a green checkmark will appear beside videos you have completed to keep track of your progress.



2. In case you want to access your content without access to the internet, you can select Download Course to download the entire course or the download button beside individual parts of the course.



- To access your downloaded content. Go to the My Learning tab and it should be at the top of the page. Click Show All to see a list of all your downloaded courses.

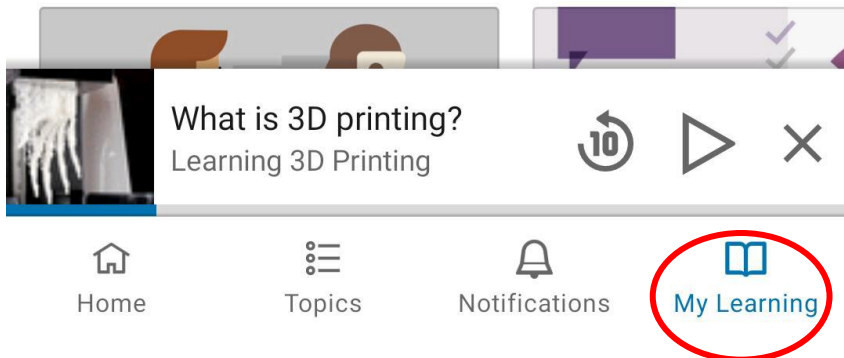

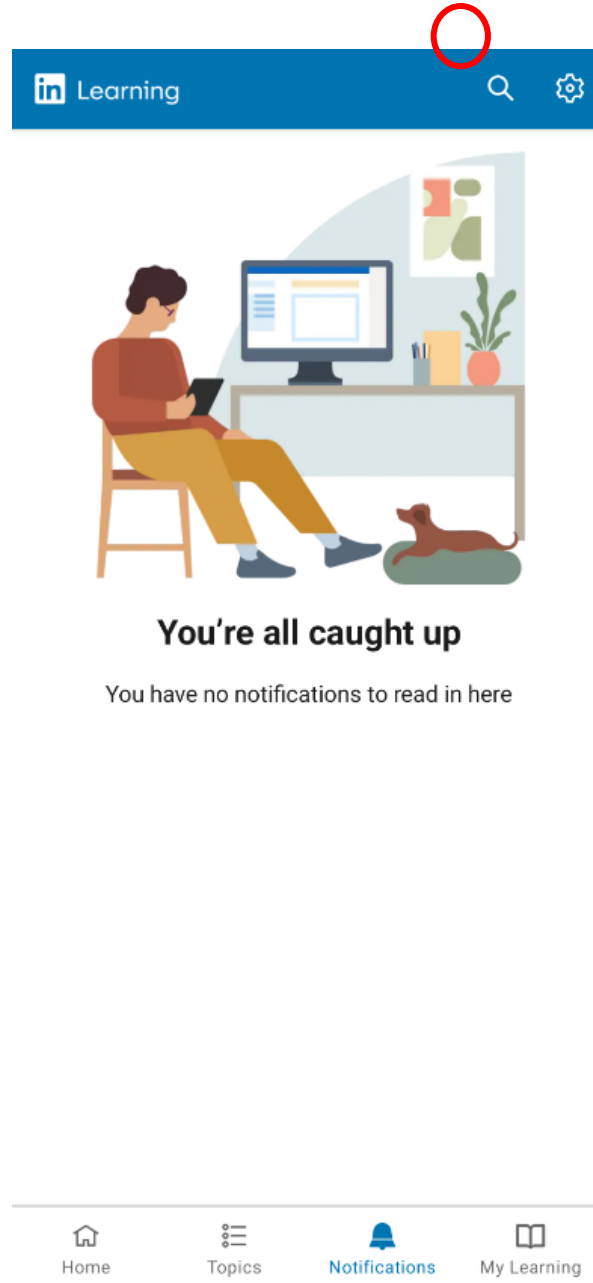

Settings

1. Settings for the app are located under the Notifications tab. Just tap the gear to open them up.



2. Once you are in settings, you can adjust many of your preferences here. The two key settings are to toggle off Cellular Downloads and choose where you want to save your downloads (internal or external storage). Not all options will be available depending on your device.
