We continue to host socials, book clubs and special speakers for adults online. Programs for children of all ages include virtual storytimes, STEAM videos and downloadable activities, and in the coming weeks we will be launching our first Virtual Science Fair, Teen Summer Challenge and TD Summer Reading Club.
