

# Creepy Crawly Soap

*Scare the germs right off your hands with this soap bar.*

## Supplies Needed

- Clear glycerin soap base
- 1 teaspoon melted coconut oil
- 5 drops of your favourite essential oil
- 1/4 teaspoon mica powder
- 1/2 teaspoon isopropyl or rubbing alcohol (99 percent alcohol volume)
- Soap mold
- Small plastic spiders
- Microwavable bowl
- Knife (use with the help of an adult)
- Ziplock bag or plastic container (for storage)



## Directions:

1. With the help of an adult, cut the clear glycerin soap base into 1-inch squares.
2. Place 6, 1-inch squares of glycerin soap base in the microwavable bowl.
3. Heat for 30 second intervals until melted. Use caution as the bowl may become hot.
4. Add coconut oil, essential oil, mica powder and isopropyl (rubbing alcohol) to the bowl of melted soap base. Mix well.
5. Rub the soap mold cavities with a tiny bit of rubbing alcohol to keep the soap from sticking to the mold.
6. Pour the soap mixture into each cavity, filling each halfway.
7. Allow the soap to harden (about 5-10 minutes).
8. Place a few small plastic spiders into each soap cavity.
9. Carefully fill each soap cavity with the remainder of the soap mixture.
10. Allow the soap to set overnight before removing from the soap mold.
11. Store each soap bar in an individual Ziplock bag until ready to use.
