## Web on a Plate!

Make the coolest spider web ever while also working on their fine motor skills! But be warned: don't eat from this plate!

## Supplies Needed:

- Black round paper plates
- Hole puncher
- White yarn
- Scissors
- Spiders cut out of construction paper
- Tape (optional)

## Directions:

- Have an adult use a hole puncher to cut out holes all around the paper plate about 1cm from the edge.
- 2. Cut a long piece of yarn that is long enough to go through all the holes on the plate.
- 3. Have the child thread the yarn through the holes.
- 4. After threading the yarn through the last hole have the adult make a knot.
- 5. Have the child add the cut-outs of the spiders on top of the web of yarn.
- 6. Optional put a piece of tape under the yarn and spider to ensure the spider does not fall off.
- 7. Hang up for Halloween!
