

Web on a Plate!

Make the coolest spider web ever while also working on their fine motor skills! But be warned: don't eat from this plate!

Supplies Needed:

- Black round paper plates
- Hole puncher
- White yarn
- Scissors
- Spiders cut out of construction paper
- Tape (optional)

Directions:

1. Have an adult use a hole puncher to cut out holes all around the paper plate - about 1cm from the edge.
2. Cut a long piece of yarn that is long enough to go through all the holes on the plate.
3. Have the child thread the yarn through the holes.
4. After threading the yarn through the last hole have the adult make a knot.
5. Have the child add the cut-outs of the spiders on top of the web of yarn.
6. Optional - put a piece of tape under the yarn and spider to ensure the spider does not fall off.
7. Hang up for Halloween!
